

Create a citation and a reference for all material you find. See Cite them Right for advice on citing web pages. If it's not your original idea, acknowledge it!

Look for royalty free images and check usage rights. Use image sites such as Pixabay, Unsplash or Flickr which organise photos according to their usage rights and acknowledge the sources you find. Google offers a 'Usage rights' filter but it's not fool-proof and you need to check the original website to be sure that you have permission to reuse content.

When creating a presentation, you should always include a slide acknowledging your sources just as you would an essay. This includes all quotations, ideas and images you find.
